GET:SCREENED Program Transitions Claims Processing to Mountain Pacific

Providers participating in GET:SCREENED (formerly the North Dakota Colorectal Cancer Screening Initiative, or NDCRCSI) should be aware of an important administrative change. Effective **June 30, 2026, Mountain Pacific** became the program's fiscal intermediary and third-party payor, replacing Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Dakota (BCBSND) for claims processing and reimbursement.

Participating facilities must complete Mountain Pacific [vendor enrollment forms](#), including a Vendor Request for Information, electronic funds transfer (EFT) form and Form W-9 to ensure timely reimbursement. Claims for covered colorectal cancer screening services should now be submitted through the [GET:SCREENED billing portal](#).

Providers and facilities can access billing resources, vendor forms, reimbursement information and the "[What's Covered](#)" document at the program's new website: www.ndgetscreened.org.

This transition supports the continued delivery of colorectal cancer screening services to eligible North Dakotans while streamlining program administration and payment processes.

FAQs

Q. When should we begin using the new claims filing system?

All claims submitted after **June 30, 2026**, must be submitted through the GET:SCREENED billing portal and will be processed by Mountain Pacific.

Q. What happens if our facility has not completed the vendor enrollment forms?

Claims may still be submitted; however, payment cannot be issued until all required vendor enrollment forms have been completed and approved.

Q. Can we continue submitting claims to BCBSND?

No. BCBSND ceased claims processing for the GET:SCREENED program on **June 30, 2026**. All new claims must be submitted through the GET:SCREENED emergency department billing portal for processing by Mountain Pacific.

Q. How can we determine which services are covered?

Refer to the "[What's Covered](#)" document available on the [GET:SCREENED website](#) for detailed coverage information, Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes and reimbursement guidance.

Q. What if we need to correct a previously submitted claim?

- Claims originally processed by BCBSND cannot be adjusted through BCBSND after June 30, 2026.

Join an NDCCRT Workgroup and Help Advance CRC Screening in North Dakota

Following the successful Action Lab at the North Dakota Colorectal Cancer Roundtable (NDCCRT) Annual Meeting on April 30, we are turning ideas into action. Through a collaborative crowdsourcing activity, members identified practical strategies to improve colorectal cancer (CRC) screening across North Dakota. To move this work forward, NDCCRT is launching four workgroups and invites members to get involved.

Workgroup opportunities include:

- **Awareness, Policy and Sustainability** – Increase CRC awareness, support policy initiatives and build sustainable systems that promote screening and early detection.
- **Provider Engagement and Health Systems Improvement** – Strengthen clinical practices, improve care processes and support providers in recommending and tracking screening.
- **Screening Access and Uptake** – Enhance patient outreach, navigation and follow-through to increase screening completion rates statewide.
- **Health Equity and Priority Populations** – Address disparities in CRC screening and outcomes through targeted outreach and community partnerships.

Whether you can participate regularly or contribute occasionally, your expertise and perspective are valuable. Workgroup activities are expected to begin in late summer, with workgroup leads and next steps announced once membership is finalized.
